#### **A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

When offered the opportunity to direct this production during a pandemic, I was hesitant. This show is tactile, loud, participatory, and in your face - how could I create a production that not only honors the original script, but also elevates it enough to give it a unique voice. This challenge is the very reason I accepted the offer. In June of 2016 I was in the middle of the rehearsal process for a production of Spelling Bee. On an off day I received a phone call that my dad had been struck by a car while on his bicycle and had not survived the accident. My director at the time just so happened to be Lena Feliciano, the creator of Celebration Theatre Company. After the funeral, I was unsure how to return to such a comedic, fun, lighthearted show following such a devastating tragedy. What I found was that this show is not just a surface level comedy. Each of these characters are written with a depth, and a heartbreak, and a truth that is often overlooked in many productions. During one of the most difficult times in my life, this show gave me an outlet and a home to explore tragedy and darkness through love and light. Directing a show during a pandemic is not something I ever thought I would do. However, when given the chance to bring the same sense of hope to an audience during a time that everyone has a need for it, I couldn't say no. This entire team has worked tirelessly to bring heart and truth to this off the wall script while ensuring we maintain the unparalleled zaniness of these iconic characters.

I hope this production at the very least gives you two hours of escape. I hope that it shows you that whether you're doing your worst, doing your best, winning, losing, or just existing – we have all had the conviction to make it where we are today – and that is what is important.
